#### 3rd and 4th Grades

The goal in third and 4th grades is to develop listening skills, speaking skills, and exposure to the culture of France. This goal is achieved through the incorporation of role playing, songs, music movement and simple conversations into daily classroom activities. Visuals and manipulatives are also used to enhance learning of the language.

The curriculum for 3rd and 4th grades includes the following concepts: greetings, colors, numbers, weather, seasons, days of the week, months of the year, family members, food, telling time and animals.

#### Middle School

In the Middle School, the French Language program stresses the four basic language skills: listening, reading, speaking and writing. Vocabulary building and grammatical concepts are essential to the study of the French language. Therefore memorization is expected in order to master the skills necessary to communicate in French. Students should review the material covered in class on a daily basis.
